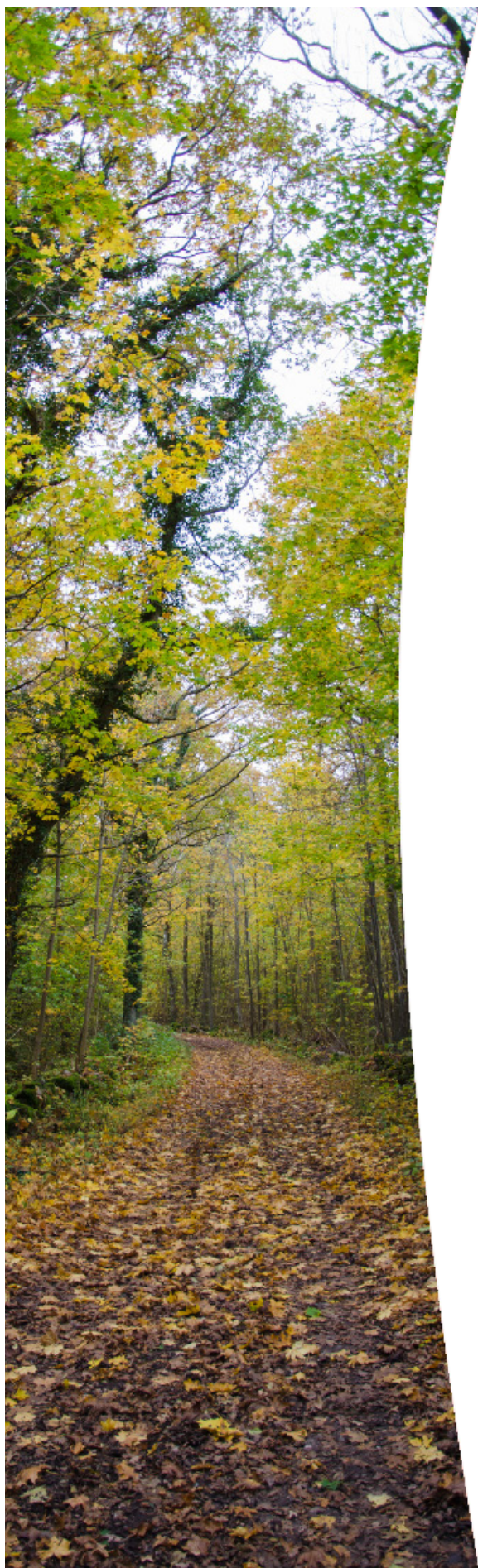
National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

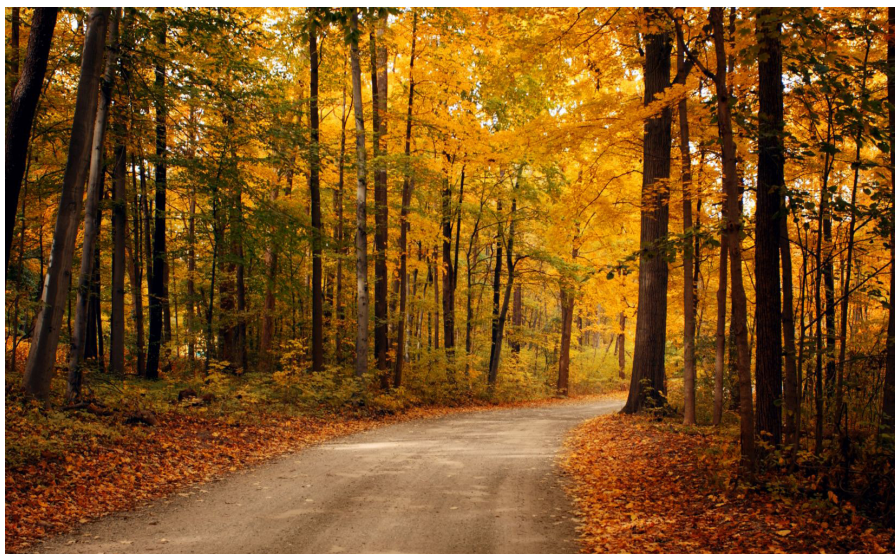
Watercolour Wednesdays

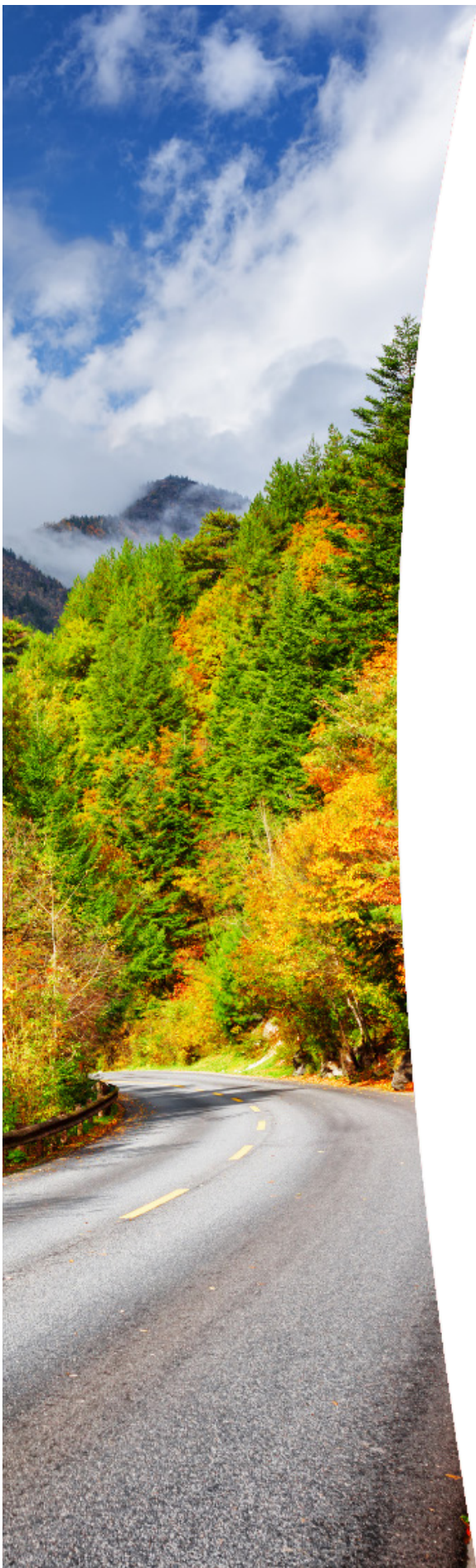

Plan to join this passionate and caring group at their next meeting: **October 30** at 1pm. If you have never knitted before, come and learn. Meet friends over shared creative skills.

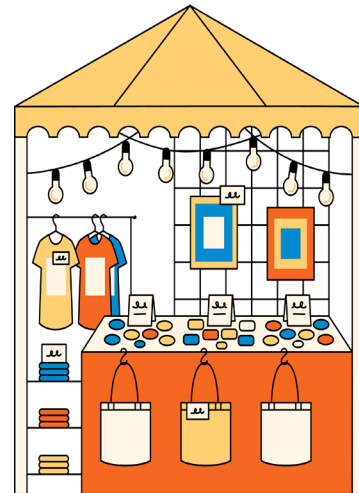

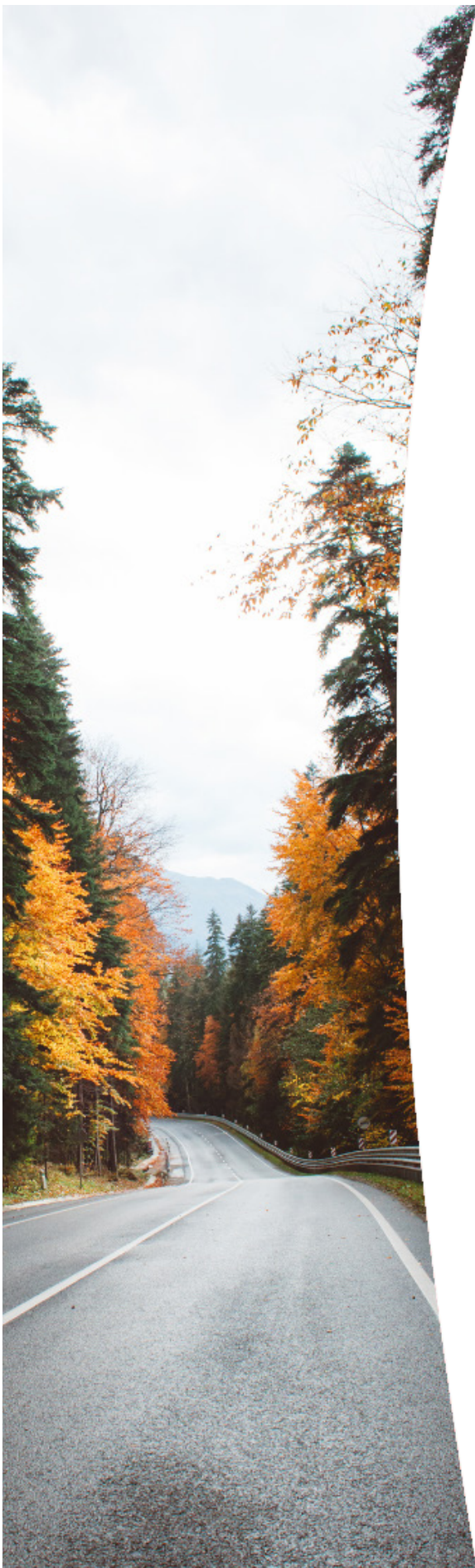
