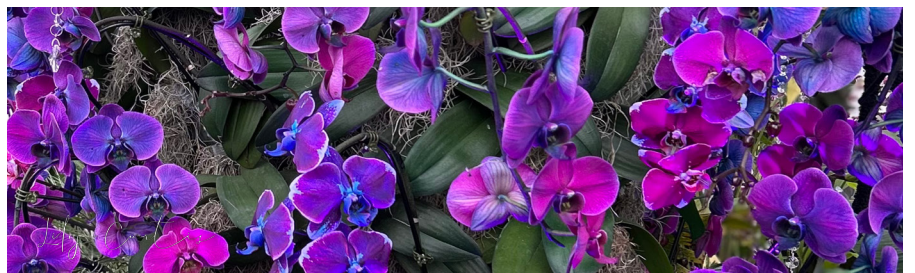

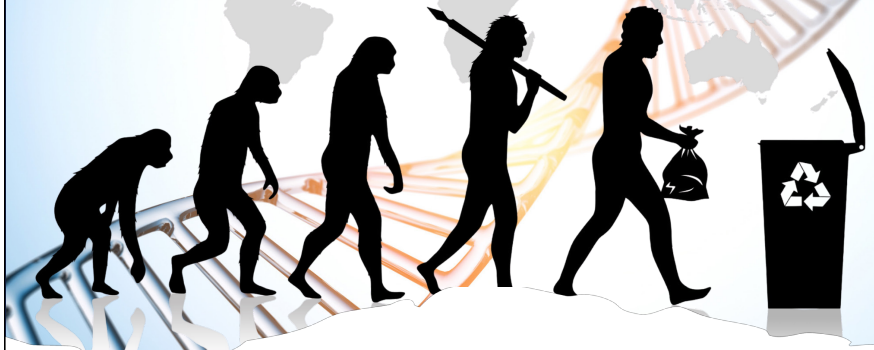

Our group will meet in the Preschool Room with coffee and conversation. Next meetings: Monday, April 13 and 27 at 2pm.



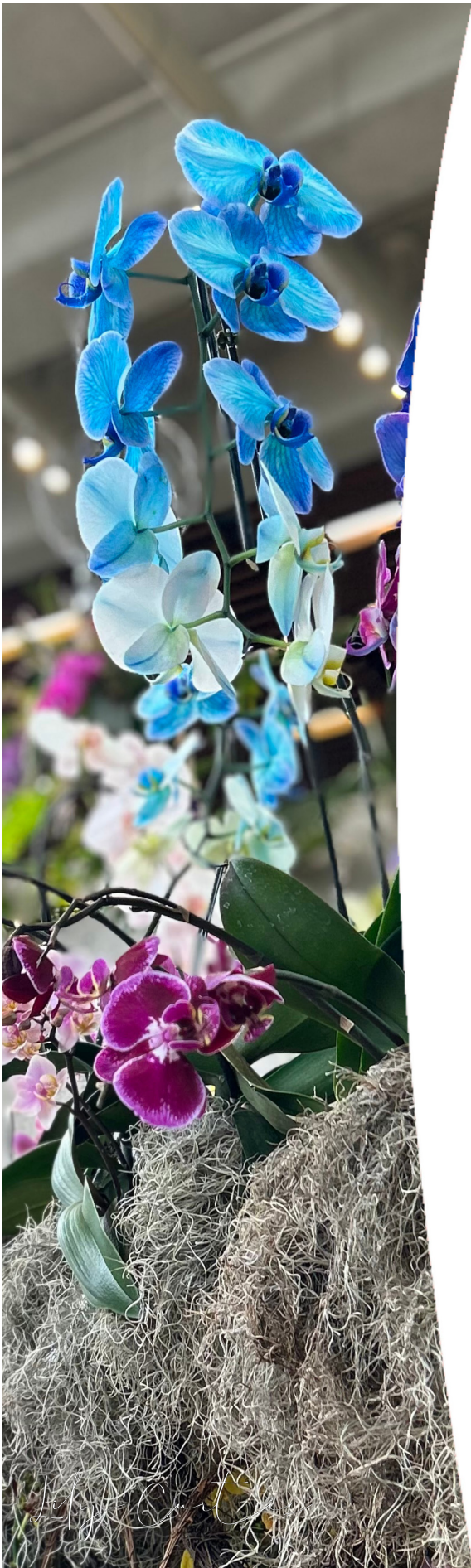

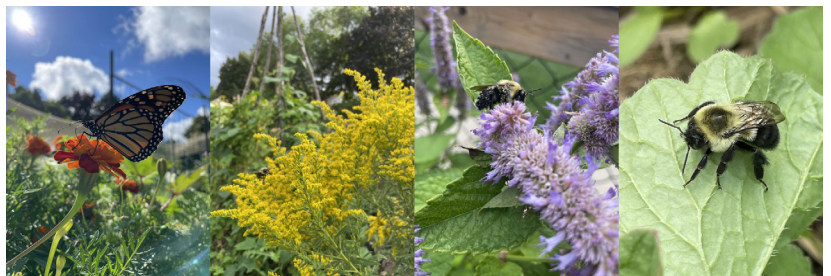

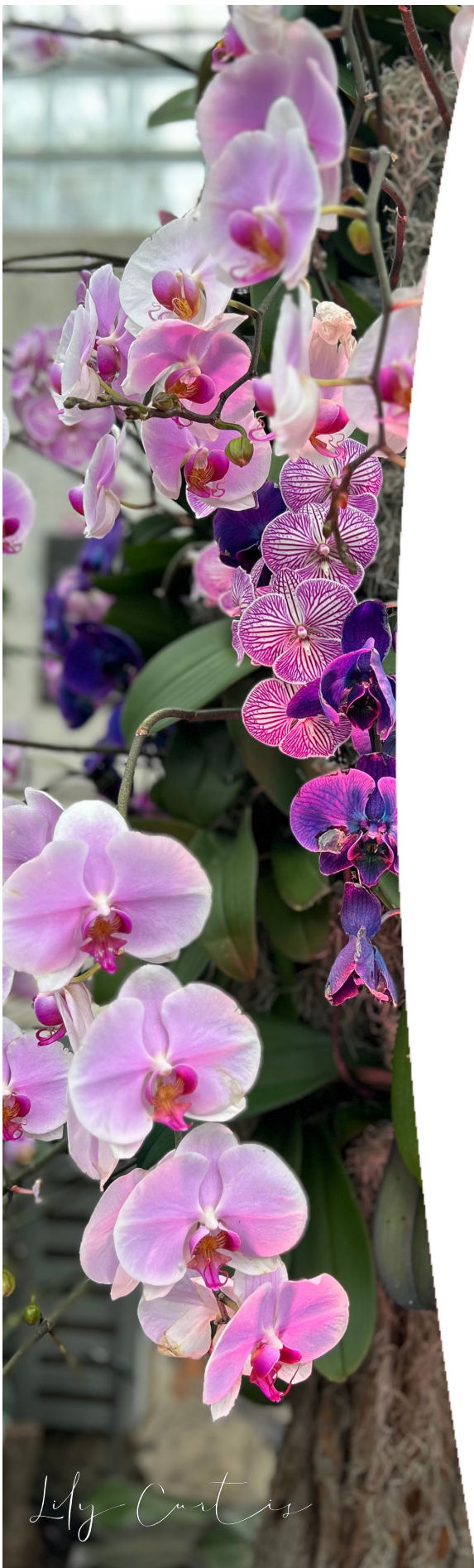
